## CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF A STUDENT INTERESTED IN EXPERIENCING A TRAINEESHIP IN CZECH REPUBLIC

**DEADLINE: 7 February 2007**

The Association of Veneto Chambers of Commerce, Venice (IT), Lead Partner of the project MOBILITY vs MIGRATION, financed under a call launched by the European Commission – DG Employment, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities within the 2006 European Year of Workers' Mobility, in partnership with TARA Professionals, o.p.s. Czech Republic, launches a call for proposals for the identification of an **Italian or British** student, interested in taking part in the experimental phase foreseen by the project. The pilot experience will consist of a **2 months (March-April 2007) traineeship** period in a **Czech company**, called **Hutní projekt Frýdek Místek** ([www.hpfm.cz](http://www.hpfm.cz)) and will be monitored by the project partners.

### Objectives

To promote mobility, raising workers and employers **awareness on the opportunities offered** by the implementation of the free movement of workers within the European territory.

### Hosting company

The company **Hutní projekt Frýdek Místek** offers a **2 months traineeship** and about **320,00 euro** per month, as expenses reimbursement. The job offered will consist of:

- **Teaching English language to the companies' employees.**

### Target group

The call for proposals addresses students who are still attending University courses, or have just finished them (up to 18 months) and that would like to have a job experience abroad.

### Requisites:

1. 18-32 years old;
2. Being enrolled at University (student who finished at least 3 years of present University studies);

3. *Communication and pedagogical skills*
4. *Excellent level of English knowledge in the field of technical, building or IT sector;*
5. *Good level of informatics competences;*

### **Procedure and deadline for the submission of the proposals**

The proposals to the pilot experience, submitted on the basis of the format attached, have to be sent by **7 February 2007** to **Unioncamere del Veneto, via delle Industrie, 19/d – 30175 Venice (ITALY)**.
