CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE IDENTIFICATION OF A STUDENT INTERESTED IN EXPERIENCING A TRAINEESHIP IN ITALY

DEADLINE: 7 February 2007

The Association of Veneto Chambers of Commerce, Venice (IT), Lead Partner of the project MOBILITY vs MIGRATION, financed under a call launched by the EC – DG Employment, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities within the 2006 European Year of Workers' Mobility, in partnership with TARA Professionals o.p.s. (Czech Republic), launches a call for proposals for the identification of a Czech student, interested in taking part to the experimental phase foreseen by the project. The pilot experience will consist in a three months traineeship period in an Italian company and will be monitored by the project partners.

Objectives

To promote mobility, raising workers and employers **awareness on the opportunities offered** by the implementation of the free movement of workers within the European territory.

Hosting company

The company, located near Treviso, in the North of Italy, is a lead developer of High Technology Systems: high performance artificial vision systems and measurement systems based on laser interferometry and telemetry.

The company Tecnogamma (www.tecnoeuropa.it) offers a three months traineeship; the job offered will consist of:

- **Working on a project whose research activities will be applied in the Czech railways.**

Target

The call for proposals addresses students who are still attending University courses, or have just finished them (up to 18 months) and that would like to have a job experience abroad.

Requisite:

1. Czech citizenship;
2. 18-32 years old;
3. being enrolled at University or being graduated student;
4. Title of qualification: Engineering, with specialization in transport or electronic;
5. Excellent level of English knowledge;
6. Excellent informatics competences;

Procedure and deadline for the submission of the proposals
